



## WAX REPORT - Eastern Cup #1, Quarry Road Trails, Classic Sprints

Date: December 16, 2023

Location: Waterville, Maine

Snow & Weather Conditions
Friday, Sunny with a high of 43F, southwest wind 5 to 10 mph. Winds will have a softening effect on course, especially areas in direct sun.
Friday night a low of 32F.
Saturday will be partly sunny with a high of 38F.
Saturday night low of 22F.
Sunday will be cloudy with a high of 42F, 5 mph wind.
Course may soften as the course is raced on. Man made snow will hold up but track will soften.
Saturday races are Classic Sprints.

<p>Glide:HS8 Glide Wax ironed in 150C. HS8 Liquid sprayed on ski and distributed over base with Combi felt cork (T0021). Let ski dry for 5 minutes and then brush with Fine Red Nylon brush (T0190B or T01900). Repeat liquid application between heats. Test Red Turbo block (TST08-2) applied with roto fleece and roto wool.</p> <p>Kick:Base klister spray, let cool avoid sun on ski base. Test Silver Universal and KX45 klisters.</p> <p>Structure:0.5 mm V-structure and potentially moving toward 1.0 mm depending on sun.</p>	<p>Glide:TSP8 Glide Wax (TSP08-4) ironed in 160C. TS8 Liquid (TS08L-12US) sprayed on ski and distributed over base with Combi fet cork (T0021). Allow liquid to dry and brush out with Fine Red Nylon brush (T0190B or T01900). Test HS8 Liquid as well and test Red Turbo block (TST08-2) applied with roto fleece and roto wool.</p> <p>Kick:Base klister spray, let cool avoid sun on ski base. Test Silver Universal and KX45 klisters.</p> <p>Structure:0.5 mm V-structure and potentially moving toward 1.0 mm depending on sun.</p>
