Snow & Weather Conditions

Friday

A 30 percent chance of snow, mainly before 9am. Cloudy, then gradually becoming mostly sunny, with a high near 33. North wind 5 to 10 mph, with gusts as high as 15 mph.

Friday Night

Mostly clear, with a low around 11. Blustery, with a north wind 10 to 15 mph, with gusts as high as 25 mph.

Saturday

Increasing clouds, with a high near 31. North wind 5 to 10 mph becoming southwest in the afternoon.

Saturday Night

A 40 percent chance of snow after 1am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 22. South wind 5 to 10 mph becoming east in the evening.

Sunday

Snow. High near 32. Breezy, with an east wind 15 to 20 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph. Chance of precipitation is 90%. New snow accumulation of 1 to 3 inches possible.

Sunday Night

Snow. The snow could be heavy at times. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 27. Breezy, with an east wind around 20 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph.

Monday

Snow before 1pm, then snow, possibly mixed with rain. The snow could be heavy at times. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 34. Windy, with a northeast wind 20 to 25 mph, with gusts as high as 40 mph.

Monday Night

Snow, possibly mixed with rain, becoming all snow after 1am. Mostly cloudy, with a low around 24. Windy, with a northeast wind 15 to 25 mph, with gusts as high as 35 mph.

Tuesday

Snow likely. Mostly cloudy, with a high near 33. Breezy, with a northwest wind 15 to 20 mph, with gusts as high as 30 mph.

<p>Glide Wax: Marathon White ironed in at 155c, scrape and brush. Roto wool TST8, brush.</p> <p>Top Coat: HS7 Liquid applied with fleece cork (T00021) and let dry. Roto fleece (T0018F) and then brush. Thinner layer is better.</p> <p>Structure: T0424050V</p>	n/a

NOTES: Marathon White because of new snow on course. Extremely durable and resists slowing ski speed in distance events. Colder liquid for the start and then Turbo 8 will address warming conditions. HS liquids perform well in fresh snow conditions.
