Snow & Weather Conditions	
Tuesday Sunny, with a high near 44. Northwest wind 11 to 16 mph.	
Tuesday Night Mostly clear, with a low around 26. West wind 5 to 9 mph becoming calm after midnight.	
Wednesday A slight chance of snow showers between 10am and 11am, then a slight chance of rain showers after 11am. Partly sunny, with a high near 51. Calm wind becoming southwest 5 to 8 mph in the afternoon. Chance of precipitation is 20%.	
Pay attention to structure.	
Wax Testing will continue throughout the day on Tuesday. Limited supply of KN44, apx. 10 tubes left at Wax Cabin 21.

Roto fleece (T0018F) and brush.</p> <p>Test TS10 Liquid Roto Fleece and TST10 Roto Wool applications.</p> <p>Structure: T0410-100V</p> <p>Binder: KB20 Spray Klister Binder</p> <p>Kick: KN44 or KX75 or K22</p>	<p>Glide wax and Kick wax testing will take place today and various temperatures.</p> <p>Stop by Cabin 21 for the current test data.</p>

NOTES: Snow will transform today and Klister will be used on Wednesday.

Structure will become more important as precipitation becomes straight rain.

Make sure you have the proper T.B.S. baskets. Course will become softer as temperatures increase. There are 3 pairs of large baskets remaining at the Swix Wax Cabin (cabin 21).
